Requirements:

→ Candidates will be required to complete an essay.

The essay should reflect their community service, participation in sports, leadership and sportsmanship.

Or

The candidate can share with us a personal story about a challenge that they have encountered in their life

→ Two letters of recommendation will be required. The letters must come from a coach, school, employer, a religious organization, a volunteer organization or a youth organization. Both letters must not be from the same type of reference.

Plan to submit early so we can alert you to any missing documentation. We will alert you if you are missing any supporting documentation 2 weeks prior to the due date.

Eligibility for the BWSF scholarships:

- Candidates must be a current High School student, junior year or above.
- Candidates must plan on attending an accredited post-secondary school.
- Relatives of candidates may not participate in the selection process.
- Candidates must reside in NY, NJ or CT and bowl in a USBC sanctioned league.
- Previous scholarship winners are not eligible.

Process for determining scholarship winners:

- Application deadline is May 15th
- Candidates will be required to complete this application.
- Candidates will evaluated based on application, essay and letters of recommendation
- Financial need will not be a factor.
- The Smith family has the discretion to award additional winners

Scholarships:

- The number of scholarships awarded annually will be determined by the BWSF Board of Directors.
- The amount of each scholarship will be a minimum of \$500. The amount of each award will be determined by the BWSF Board of Directors.
- Scholarship funds will be deposited into the recipient's SMART account. If a winner does not have a SMART account, one will be set up for him/her.
- Winners will be announced on or about May 31th. The scholarship will be awarded at the annual BWSF awards picnic in June.
