COVID-19

We continue to be vigilant in Laxdale School and although many of the restrictions have been lifted we still follow the Premises Risk Assessment which was recently updated.

We continue to ask parents to communicate with us regarding their child's absence. There are specific codes for recording different absences and it is important we record the correct one.

Please follow the guidelines in the recent Parent Briefing from CNES regarding a child developing symptoms.

CAUTION ADVISED AS RULES RELAX AND LOCAL CASES RISE

Whilst our schools welcome further news of the relaxation of COVID-19 restrictions, we do so with caution as, at the same time, we are currently seeing increased reports of virus transmission in several communities in the Western Isles.

With this in mind, schools will be proceeding with caution when reducing measures and restrictions and will be taking account of the immediate numbers of cases in the local area. As a result, it is possible that, in the coming weeks, schools in the Western Isles may operate different levels of restrictions that reflect their local community circumstances. The national guidance acts as a minimum expectation and head teachers will continue to make local decisions about restrictions affecting their schools whilst taking account of local public health advice.

We continue to strongly encourage everyone to follow the latest NHS advice:

- Get fully vaccinated
- Wear a face covering wherever it's required
- Wash hands frequently
- Cover nose and mouth if coughing/sneezing
- Test regularly
- Open windows when meeting people indoors
- If you have symptoms, act quickly. Isolate and seek a test.

Reading Challenge

As part of our focus on literacy in Laxdale school, we intend to involve every pupil in a reading challenge. The Reading Challenge will aim to see every child read a minimum of 6 books in 6 weeks.

Six Books in Six Weeks

Books can either be children's weekly library book selection, a book from the class library or a book from home. Each pupil has been issued with a 'loyalty card' which will be punched once a week, on completion of at least one book. The loyalty cards will be kept in school. Each child will keep a record of the books read and these will also be kept in school. At the end of the challenge each child will receive a reward of a hot chocolate drink for their reading efforts.

We will be aiming for children to have completed their first book and receive their first stamp by the end of next week.

Younger readers will require support from parents, carers or older siblings and their stamp can be given for books that have been read with or to them.




