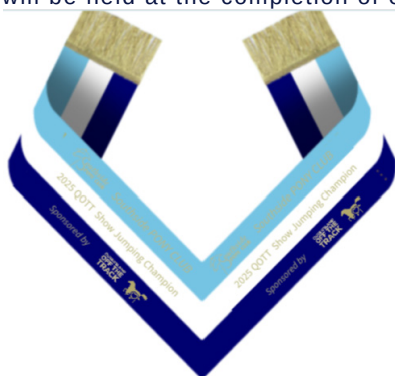

RIDER NUMBERS	Please bring your own rider number – back number holders, saddle and / or bridle numbers are acceptable.
FIRST AID	First Aid will be in attendance in accordance with Pony Club Australia.
RULES	<p>The event will be run under the current PCQ Show Jumping rules and the current 2025 PCA Gear Check rules.</p> <p>At the discretion of the organising committee, riders may enter 2 horses in the following way:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Riders may enter two horses in the same or different heights Each horse may gain qualifying results Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards <p>Nominations must include riders PCQ membership number. Once nominated, classes cannot be changed on the day.</p>
PERFORMANCE CARDS	Completed performance cards are required for classes 1-9 and must be handed in prior to the commencement of event. If no card is presented the rider will ride HC.
HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION	Horse and Participant Health Declarations are to be submitted online or handed in to the nomination desk prior to the start of the event.
WEATHER	In case of inclement weather, check our Facebook event page.
HELPERS	All riders are to provide a helper as per event entry on Nominate. To ensure the smooth running of the competition, we will be asking for helpers to help adjust the courses and pick up rails during the event.
REFUNDS	<p>Refunds or scratchings will incur a Nominate fee.</p> <p>Refunds after the closing date will require a doctor or vet certificate and will incur Nominate fee.</p>
PROTESTS	Protests should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and accompanied by a \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.
DISCLAIMER	Neither the organising committee, PCAQ, Southside Pony Club or venue providers Runcorn Pony Club accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any horse, owner, rider or any other person or property.
CODE OF CONDUCT	PCQ and Southside Pony Club Code of Conduct will be enforced. Bad language, excessive striking of horse, abuse or disrespect will result in immediate disqualification.
