DAILY CARE

PentalQuartz requires very little maintenance. Simply wipe your surface with any commonly available multi-purpose cleaner or mild detergent, then rinse off with clean water. The surface should be cleaned on a regular basis to maintain its beauty.

DISINFECT

To disinfect your quartz countertop, we recommend using store bought disinfecting wipes and rinsing with water.

STAIN REMOVAL

Our engineered quartz is a virtually care-free surface, but spills do happen and excessive abuse can harm its finish. It is best to address stains and spills as quickly as possible.

For stubborn spills and stains, apply a mild, non-abrasive household cleanser with a neutral pH (between 6 and 8) and rub with a damp soft cloth or nonabrasive sponge, then rinse thoroughly with clean water. Note: It is possible that some of the stubborn stains may leave a light mark or very slight discoloration on the surface. Before trying a more powerful cleaning agent, please test on a small, less conspicuous area of the surface. If there is no negative reaction then proceed to clean the affected area. The same testing should be applied for a cleaning agent which has been kept for a long time without using.

For food, chewing gum, nail polish, paint or any foreign matters that are strongly adhered to any PentalQuartz surface, simply scrape them away with a sharp plastic scraper. Wash and rinse the surface with clean water.

CHEMICALS TO AVOID

Avoid exposing your quartz surface to strong chemicals and solvents such as:

- Acetone
- Permanent Markers or Inks
- Oil Soaps
- Furniture Cleaners
- Paint Thinner

- Glue Stripper
- High Alkaline/PH Level Chemicals, such as oven cleaners
- Water Repellents or Sealants
- Bleach or Solvents

HONED FINISHES

PentalQuartz is offered in two finishes, polished and honed. Just as each finish has a different look, they also have slightly different characteristics. Honed finish colors offer the soft appearance of a lower sheen compared to the polished finish.

The honed finishes require slightly more maintenance. Since the honed finish actually creates more surface area to the material, it has the potential to show more signs of living from daily use. Possible marks from metal cookware or utensils, fingerprints, food and beverages, and other items placed on, or moved across the countertop, may be visible on the surface. Most marks can be easily removed with a cloth or sponge, or by using household cleaners such as a cleaning eraser or carefully scrubbing with a sponge and a nonabrasive cleaner.

Over time, the honed finish will develop character and a patina unique to each customer. Honed finishes can be cleaned using the same products and methods as other finishes. Please see our care and maintenance guide on the website at arcsurfaces.com. The warranty issued by Architectural Surfaces for PentalQuartz covers manufacturing defects; however the temporary marks that commonly occur on honed finishes are inherent to the material, and are not covered under the terms of the warranty.

PRECAUTIONS

Although PentalQuartz is extremely scratch resistant, it is not scratch proof. You should never cut or chop directly on your countertop. Always use a cutting board. Always use a hot pad or trivet when setting down hot objects, such as hot pans or plates. Direct contact with extremely high heat can cause damage. Care should also be taken when using electric household appliances that may emit high heat such as crock pots, electric skillets, etc. as these can potentially damage the surface.
