Planting Sizes Guideline:

Whether you're planting seedlings or large, mature trees, here's a quick breakdown of typical starting sizes to consider for your spacing:

1 gal (Seedlings)
5 gal (Little bigger)
15 gal (6ft tall, 1-inch diameter)
30 gal (10-12ft tall, 1.5-2inch diameter)
45 gal (15-17ft tall, 3-inch diameter)
65 gal (16-20ft tall, 4-inch diameter)
100 gal (20-25ft tall, 6-inch diameter, up to 20 years old! Often costly)

No matter what size you choose, proper watering is key, especially with the dry conditions we're experiencing. Hydrate!
