ARE YOUR TREES STORM READY?



PROPER PRUNING

- Thin Out by 20%: Allows better wind passage and sunlight penetration.
- Remove Large Dead Limbs: Decreases the risk of falling branches.
- Properly Elevate Trees: Keep branches at least 5-7 feet away from the roof, 12-14 feet above the street, and 8-10 feet above the yard.



PROPER WATERING

- Trees with well-hydrated roots and limbs are more flexible and less likely to break compared to dehydrated ones.
