Workshop Frequently Asked Questions

What is Creative Critters?

Creative Critters is a hands■on creative workshop program where children participate in fun art, craft, and building activities designed to spark creativity and confidence.

Who leads the workshops?

Workshops are led by an experienced educator with extensive experience working with children in both academic and enrichment environments.

What ages are the workshops designed for?

Most workshops are designed for children ages 4–10, though some sessions may be better suited for specific age groups.

How long are the workshops?

Most Creative Critters workshops last approximately 45–60 minutes depending on the activity.

What types of activities will children do?

Children may complete seasonal crafts, creative art projects, small building activities, puzzles, and other hands■on themed projects.

Do parents stay during the workshop?

Parent participation depends on the location. Some venues allow parents to stay nearby while others may ask parents to wait in a designated area.

How much does a workshop cost?

Most Creative Critters workshops range between \$10–\$20 per child depending on materials and the activity.

Do children need to bring anything?

No. All materials are provided. Children just need to come ready to create and have fun.

How do I register my child?

Registration is completed online through a registration form. Space is limited and advance registration is recommended.

Is there a maximum number of children per session?

Yes. Workshops are typically limited to about 20 children so that each child receives attention and support.

What happens if the session fills up?

If a workshop reaches capacity, families may be offered another session or placed on a waitlist.

Will there be additional workshops in the future?

Yes. Creative Critters plans to offer seasonal workshops throughout the year with different creative themes.
