A Note From Our Pastor

Scripture tells us in Genesis 2 that after God had worked for six days creating all the good things in this world, God rested on the seventh day. An omnipotent God, who never tires, did not necessarily need to rest after a long week of work, but God was establishing a rhythm for the world he had created. The plants of this world have periods of dormancy, which make the periods of growth more effective. There are seasons in our year, and even the daily cycle of sunlight and darkness reminds us of the rhythm of the world God created. As people, we are not the exception. We also need to live according to the rhythm that God has created. We need a consistent, intentional break. Scripture calls this break Sabbath.

A Sabbath for us is a time of recharging and recalibrating our minds, our bodies, and our souls to be in tune with the way God created us. It is more than a day off from our normal activities. It is pausing and realigning ourselves with God in every way, and then re-engaging with all that God has called us to for our lives.

I believe that a Sabbath is beneficial for us on a weekly basis and on an annual basis as well. Build in time weekly to not only rest your body but rest your mind and recalibrate to God. And, somehow, in the midst of our annual action packed vacations from work, make time to be dormant, following the model of the world around us.

For those who are retired from work, the idea of Sabbath may look a little different. But, you still need to consistently pause from your normal routine to align your mind and soul with who God created you to be, and then re-engage with what God has called you to do.

It was only through God's timing and provisions from Shearer Hills and the delivery of Boy Scouts donation from the previous Saturday that allowed up to go on that Tuesday as normal to serve the community. That week we served nearly 200 families. This would not have been possible without your timely support. God is good! This is only one of many stories that could be told about the impact that Shearer Hills has on not only our community, but also West Avenue Compassion.
