A Note From Our Pastor

We had a great staff retreat a couple of weeks ago. Thanks for praying for us! I am thankful to serve alongside good friends who are faithful in their pursuit to serve and glorify God. Some of you have asked about "how it went" or "what we came up with". In addition to enjoying being together and growing our relationships with one another, we had conversations and discussions that reinforced many of our current ministries and directions. As a church, we are called to be people who help people know God more, and the main ways we are seeking to do this is to engage people in studying, serving, sharpening, and sharing. We will continue to offer environments where we can study scripture together and seek to apply it to our lives, and we will look to improve those ministries any way we can. We want to encourage every person to serve in at least one significant way, realizing that in some ways we "serve-in" and in some ways we "serve-out" (considering the recipients of our serving), and knowing that we need a healthy balance between the two. We want to develop more community in our church family and encourage the community that already exists to deepen spiritually more and more as we sharpen one another, like iron sharpens iron. We need to be a church body that shares with others who Jesus is and that Jesus died on the cross for us, and we want to create more clear opportunities for our church to invite lost people to participate with us and to hear the good news of Jesus.

Hopefully, you have already noticed these themes in the various ministries of our church, and you will be hearing and seeing them more moving forward. In fact, the "New Patterns" sermon series we are finishing this Sunday mirrors the goals of studying, serving, sharpening and sharing. We also spent some of our time together refining what "wins" are for us as a church - what are we really seeking to accomplish and how we know if we are actually doing it. And related to that, we talked about steps that will help us as individuals and in ministries to "win" in various ways. I am thankful for our church and for the opportunity to serve alongside you as we seek to be who God has called us to be.
