Through our recent second "Kits4 Kids" distribution, we provided a duffle bag, a laundry bag, a children's Bible, a Chick-fil-A gift card, and a bookmark explaining salvation through Jesus. We also included in the Bible a sticker that read "God loves you and so do we!" with our church name and phone number. These bags were given to CPS investigators who are tasked with removing children from abusive or neglectful situations in San Antonio and surrounding areas. Often, children are forced to quickly gather their belongings and stuff them in a trash bag to take with them, adding to the stress and pain of an already difficult situation. Our prayer is that these "Kits4Kids" will

embody hope and care to these kids. One CPS worker told me that she was very appreciative of the



bags we gave them in the fall. She said she had recently removed five siblings from a tough situation, and she was so thankful to have the bags for them so they could gather their belongings. Another told me she recently was a part of the state taking custody of two kids who desperately needed to be bathed, and she was very grateful to have the laundry bags to put their dirty clothes into so the few other items they had could be kept separate.

Thank you to our Foster Care Ministry Team for their hard work

planning this and other ministry events for our church. Thank you to

all the volunteers who have helped with the packing and distribution in the fall and this month. And, it is donations from many within our church family that has made this ministry possible. This time, the bags and contents cost just over \$13 each. That's a great price (helped by the donation of all the gift cards by San Antonio area Chick-fil-A's), but it still adds up when



providing 1,000 bags. We are planning a third distribution in the fall

with the goal of providing a bag for every child removed this year in the San Antonio area. We will need approximately \$10,000 to complete the 3,000 kit goal.

I am glad to be part of a church that seeks to make a difference in the lives of people in our local community, and in this case - "the least of these."
