A Note From Our Pastor

I recently heard a song that used the familiar analogy comparing God's work in our lives to the wind. You can't see the wind, but you see the trees moving so you know that the wind is there. We may not be able to see God with our human eyes, but we can see God in our church because of God's work in people's lives.

We see and hear God as people share their testimonies when they are baptized. We see God in our students, demonstrated visibly

recently through DNOW weekend; we also see God present every week as students gather to worship and to study God's Word and talk about how it applies to their lives. We see God in our Sr. Adults as they love one another, as they demonstrate a life-time of faithfulness, and as they continue to serve in ways that do not necessarily benefit themselves. We see God's provision for us, blessing us with great resources and facilities so we can meet together to know Him more and share the gospel with people who do not vet know Him. We see God in our kids, as they hide scripture in their hearts and live for God with enthusiasm. We see God at work, as adults, not only in studying scripture but daring to be vulnerable with each other and talking through their struggles with faith and life. We see and hear God as we gather for worship each week, with the lyrics of songs pointing us to the truths of scripture. We see God at work through upcoming ministries like Spring Fling and the Men's Retreat; as people set aside intentional time to encounter God, God is faithful to meet with us and reveal himself to us. We see God in our kids as they learn what it means to serve like Jesus did. We see God as students ask tough questions about their faith, and as they respond to God's calling for their lives. We see God at work every time someone chooses to sacrifice their own interest and serve someone else.

We see God at work in all of these ways and so many more. In fact, hold on because it seems like it is getting pretty "windy" here.

Take a moment, as you finish reading this, and pause to consider how you see God in your life. Thank God for it. And then tell someone else about it this week.


