In this season leading up to Thanksgiving, I am thankful for all the ways that our church serves. Our year long Operation Christmas Child ministry culminated with us packing over 1300 boxes. These boxes will be sent to 1,300 precious children who might not otherwise receive a gift this Christmas. Along with the joy of a gift, the kids will also hear the gospel message that Jesus loves them and died for them. Samaritan's Purse has determined that for every 100 boxes given, 16 kids trust Christ as Savior and Lord. That means (according to the statistical precedence) over 200 kids will trust Christ through our boxes! And they and their families will be discipled through the follow-up program. Many of us also pack additional boxes as a family, growing our impact through OCC.

This fall we have emphasized our ministry to our homeless neighbors, offering showers, snacks, and words of encouragement along with our first monthly breakfast in October. We have provided school supplies for families in need, inviting families to our church to pick out their own school supplies from our donations. We have hosted hundreds of people for a fun night on our church property for Fall Festival, serving free food and running inflatables and games for them. We have volunteered numerous hours to host conferences that help people understand their identity in Christ and grow in their faith. We have mentored young moms through MOPS, hosted students in our homes, helped kids memorize scripture, and so much more.

We will soon be participating in our third Kits for Kids distribution, ministering to kids removed from their families by CPS. This is an opportunity for us to share hope with kids in our local community during some of the most stressful and tragic moments of their young lives. Not only do we give them bags to pack their belongings with dignity, but we are able to give them their very own children's Bible as well as a meal card donated by Chick-fil-A. Being a part of the distribution has been a meaningful experience for church members the past two times; so, I encourage you to consider participating on December 5. You can also give financially to help with the cost of the bags, or go buy some Cookies for a Cause on November 9 (see below).

We also have a new hands-on way to serve this year with our Christmas Celebration. After the musical, we will enjoy a meal together with guests that we individually invite to join us as well as guests from our local homeless population and foster families. After we all are encouraged with the message of Jesus through the musical, we will have an opportunity to not only visit with our friends but to engage in conversation with our special guests. Please plan to be a part of this special night and serve our local community together.


I am thankful for a church family that not only gives generously to see ministry happen, but is also willing to serve personally to be a part of how God is working in the world around us.


