**Lung Cancer**

Lung Cancer is one of the most common cancers among men and women. More than 200,000 cases are diagnosed yearly in the United States. The main cause of lung cancer is the use of cigarettes, cigars, and pipes. Other causes include exposure to asbestos, radon, radiation, and second-hand smoke.

Some people may have no symptoms until cancer is advanced. Others have long-lasting cough, coughing up bloody phlegm, shortness of breath, wheezing, recurrent pneumonia, loss of appetite, and weight loss. Swelling of the face and neck, pain in the shoulders, arms, and hands can also occur in some cases.

Early diagnosis can be hard because some people may have no symptoms until cancer is advanced. A low dose CT scan of the chest can be used to look for lung cancer in people over the age of 50 who are smokers or have a significant history of smoking. If an abnormality is noted, additional tests can be done. The only sure way to diagnose lung cancer is to take and study samples of lung fluid or tissue (biopsy).
