

Heart Attack (In Women)

Not all heart attacks look alike. Women experience heart attacks differently than men. If you find yourself suddenly drenched in sweat for no apparent reason, don't assume it is a hot flash. Sweating is one of the five symptoms of a female having a heart attack. Symptoms are often quiet and subtle. They are often mistaken for something less serious. For those reasons, women are slower to seek medical attention. That delay can mean the difference between life and death.

Five Warning Signs:

- *Sweating: Suddenly drenched in a sweat for no apparent reason and a pale, ashen face.*
- *Nausea or Dizziness: Women often vomit or feel like they are going to pass out.*
- *Breathlessness: Over half of women report panting or not being able to carry on a conversation.*
- *Sleeplessness: Nearly half of women have trouble sleeping in the month before a heart attack.*
- *Anxiety: Many women experience a sense of down or fear before a heart attack. That's your body altering you to pay attention. Trust those instincts!*

Remember: Heart attacks kill!
Pay attention to early warning signs!
Don't hesitate or question it!
Insist on the proper medical care!
