Parish Hall Rental

When you pay your rental fee, you will be given an agreement form to sign. This form will come with a set of rental rules that we ask that you please follow. There will also be copies located throughout the Parish Hall and on the bulletin board inside the Church. It is nice to see the building being used, but we all need to pitch in and monitor the thermostat and doors to help with the expense and safety of the building.

The following is a brief outline of the rules:

- There are 3 thermostats (2 in gym and 1 by the stairs going up to CCD area). Please leave the heat at 63.
- Please lock the doors by flipping the toggle switch on the metal box located to the upper right of the exit doors.
- Put things back where they were found when you came.
- Shut off all equipment (sound system, cookers/warmers, fans, lights, etc.)
- Take out garbage to the blue dumpster located by the barn.
- Provide your own tablecloths.
- Also, if you ask to borrow any tables or chairs, please let us know how many and return them in a timely manner.
- Let us know when you are done for the day.

Choking Prevention & Safety Tips for Children:

While many foods are nutritious, the forms in which they are served can be deadly for young children.

High-risk choking foods:

- Hot dogs (cut lengthwise and then widthwise)
- Hard or stick candy
- Popcorn
- Grapes
- Nuts & Seeds
- Lollipops
- Dried & Raw Fruit (cut into small enough pieces)
- Vegetables (cooked & cut into small enough pieces)
- Chips
- Chunks of Nut Butters (spread thinly on crackers/bread)

High-risk choking hazard objects:

- Coins
- Buttons
- Toys with small pieces
- Small balls/marbles
- Small batteries

Be observant to what children are playing with and find, as most young children tend to put objects right into their mouth. When eating, children should always be monitored by an adult. Make sure they are sitting up straight and eat foods that are developmentally appropriate. Children should not eat while walking, riding a bike or in a car.
