**Brain Injury Awareness**

Every 9 seconds someone in the United States sustains a traumatic brain injury (TBI). In 2021, there were 190 TIB-related deaths every day (CDC,2024).

Traumatic brain injury takes many different forms:

- Concussion
- Hemorrhage in and/or around the brain
- Disruption of the neurons (messaging system of the brain)

All of these impact how the brain works short-term and if untreated, an affect long-term function as well. TBI's can result from anything that causes the brain to be jarred within the skull. It runs the range from motor vehicles crashes to a jolt to the brain following a slip and fall. Several conditions, such alcoholism or drug use and medications (anticoagulants) increase the risk of a TBI.
