**Funerals and Funeral Plans**

The Catholic Church provides for 3 types of funerals:

- Funeral Mass
- Funeral Service in the Church
- Funeral Service in the Funeral Home setting (This would be a Family decision based on the deceased Mass going practice.)

The Church allows for cremation but really stresses that it be done after the Funeral Mass/Service if possible (i.e. the body should be present, again, if possible or affordable). Visitations may be held in the Church either the night before or the day of the funeral and the funeral music within the Service must be Church hymns. Other secular music, if appropriate, may be played before or after the Mass/Service. And of course, it is always best to pre-plan your funeral.

*You should make your wishes known to family and put it in your Will that you want a funeral Mass.*

**Celiac Disease Awareness Month**

May marks National Celiac Disease Awareness Month, a time to highlight a condition that remains widely undiagnosed despite its significant impact on health and quality of life. Celiac Disease is an autoimmune disorder in which ingestion of gluten found in wheat, barley, and rye triggers an immune response that damaged the small intestine. Because symptoms vary widely and can mimic many other conditions, early recognition is essential.

Celiac Disease affects an estimated 1% of the population. Untreated disease can lead to complications such as nutrient deficiencies, anemia, bone loss, infertility, and increased risk of other autoimmune conditions. Diagnosis involves blood tests for screening and the definitive diagnosis is dependent on a biopsy of the small bowel near the entrance of the colon or small bowel. Identifying Celiac Disease early allows individuals to begin the only current treatment, which is a strict, lifelong gluten-free diet. Early diagnosis also helps identify at-risk family members who benefit from screening.

**Key Signs & Symptoms:**


- Digestive Symptoms: chronic diarrhea, constipation, abdominal pain, bloating and nausea
- Nutritional Consequences: iron-deficiency anemia, weight loss and fatigue
- Dermatologic findings: An intensely itchy rash
- Skeletal Effects: osteoporosis or loss of calcium from the bones
- Neurologic or Systemic Symptoms: headaches, neuropathy, joint pain and mood changes
