**Women’s Health**

May is National Women’s Health Month. A time dedicated to encouraging women and girls to prioritize their physical, mental, and emotional well-being. Women’s health remains under-researched and underfunded across many critical domains. Women experience biological transitions, from puberty and pregnancy to menopause and aging, that shape lifelong health and well-being.

**Key Goals & Focus Areas:**

- **Preventive Screening:** Encouraging annual check-ups, mammograms (especially for women 40+), and screenings for blood pressure, cholesterol, and cervical health.
- **Mental Well-Being:** Addressing high rates of depression in women and managing stress, especially for caregivers.
- **Healthy Habits:** Promoting nutritious eating, consistent physical activity (at least 150 minutes a week), and reducing alcohol and tobacco use.
- **Empowerment:** Promoting self-advocacy to overcome healthcare.

**How to Participate:**

- **Schedule Check-Ups:** Use this month to schedule overdue appointments with primary care providers or specialists.
- **Educate Yourself:** Learn about health issues specific to different stages of life.
- **Use Official Tools:** Explore Office on Women’s Health website for toolkits, event information, and resources.
- **Get Active:** Participate in local, community-based health events and screenings.
