Tolerate the Heat

Be careful in the extreme heat. Do not spend an exceptional amount of time in the sun. If your work is related to working outdoors, make sure that you are able to take breaks that allow you to get some relief.

Here are some guidelines to follow:

- Drink plenty of water. Stay hydrated!!!!
- Wear a hat, even if you do not like them.
- Avoid wearing dark colored clothing, especially black!
- Use sunscreen.
- Avoid alcohol.
- Do not over exceed yourself.
- Protect young children, elderly and pets.

When playing or doing outdoor activities in the sun, it is recommended to do them in the morning and evening hours. Try to avoid the times between 11am to 4pm, which are the hottest hours in the day.

Older adults need to be checked on. Be sure that they have air conditioning or fans that work. You can get fans from the Senior Services for those who may not be able to afford them. Be sure they understand to drink adequate amounts of plan water. Discourage them from working in their yard in the hottest part of the day. Instruct them that if they have any symptoms of too much sun to cool off and call 911 if needed.
