Heat Illnesses

Know Who's At Risk:

- Older Adults
- Babies & Young Children
- Pregnant Women
- People with Chronic Conditions or Taking Medications
- People with Disabilities
- People using Drugs or Alcohol
- Athletes
- Outdoor Workers
- People without A/C or Fans
- Homeless

Heat Cramps:

- Heavy Sweating
- Muscle Pain and/or Cramps

Heat Exhaustion:

- Heavy Sweating
- Weakness
- Cool & Clammy Skin
- Muscle Cramps
- Dizziness or Fainting
- Nausea or Vomiting

Heat Stroke:

- High Body Temperature
- Rapid Heartbeat
- Confusion
- Headache
- Dizziness or Fainting
- Nausea or Vomiting

Take Action:

- Stay Hydrated: Drink a cup of water every hour. Avoid sugary, caffeinated or alcoholic drinks. Monitor your urine output and color. Dark urine means you need more water.
- Stay Cool: Spend time in places with A/C or fans and if outside, stay in the shade. Take cool showers or baths.
- Stay Connected: Talk with your doctor, sign up for local emergency alerts and check on loved ones and neighbors.
- If you experience any signs of heat cramps or exhaustion: Stop, rest in a cool place and take slow sips of water (unless you feel too sick to drink). Loosen clothes during exhaustion and place a cool, wet cloth on your body. Seek medical help if needed.
- If you experience any signs of a heat stroke, call 911. Move to a cool place and remove extra clothing. Use a wet cloth or cool bath to cool down an do not drink anything.
