

Dehydration



During these extreme hot and humid conditions, we must not forget to stay hydrated! Mornings may be cool, but as the day gets going, so does the heat. Hot days cause more cases of dehydration if the fluid intake is not adequate. Plan for the day as the heat begins to rise. Sweating may begin to increase and so will your need for fluids.

Outdoor exercises that are physically challenging, such as hiking, rock climbing, and kayaking make you more vulnerable. Older adults are more vulnerable also. Ensuring sufficient fluid intake can help people avoid dehydration.



This not always a reliable indicator that the body needs water, so it is beneficial to learn the symptoms of dehydration.

Signs & Symptoms:

- Extreme Thirst
- Less Frequent Urination
- Dark Colored Urine
- Dry Mouth
- Less Frequent Sweating
- Feeling Tired
- Dizziness
- Dry Skin

Infants & Children:

- Dry Mouth & Tongue
- Crying Without Tears
- No Wet Diapers (>3hrs)
- High Fever
- Unusually Sleepy/Drowsy
- Irritability
- Sunken Eyes
