### Heat Illnesses

#### Know Who's At Risk:

- Older adults
- Babies and young children
- Pregnant women
- People with chronic conditions or taking medications
- People with disabilities
- People using drugs or alcohol
- Athletes and outdoor workers
- People without AC or fans
- Homeless or those living alone

#### Heat Cramps:

- Heavy sweating
- Muscle Pain or cramps

#### Heat Exhaustion:

- Heavy sweating
- Weakness
- Cool & clammy skin
- Muscle cramps
- Dizziness or fainting
- Nausea or vomiting

#### Heat Stroke:

- High body temperature
- Rapid heartbeat
- Confusion
- Headache
- Dizziness or fainting
- Nausea or vomiting

#### Take Action:

- Stay Hydrated (Drink a cup of water every hour. Avoid sugary, caffeinated or alcoholic drinks. Monitor your urine output and color. Dark urine means you need more water.)
- Stay cool (Spend time in places with A/C or fans and if outside, stay in the shade. Take cool showers or baths.)
- Stay connected (Talk with your doctor, sign up for local emergency alerts and check on loved ones and neighbors.)
- If you experience any signs of heat cramps or exhaustion: Stop, rest in a cool place and take slow sips of water (unless you feel too sick to drink). Loosen clothes during exhaustion and place a cool, wet cloth on your body. Seek medical help if needed.
- If you experience any signs of a heat stroke, call 911. Move to a cool place and remove extra clothing. Use a wet cloth or cool bath to cool down and do not drink anything.
