PARISH NURSE'S CORNER

In Illinois two documents are available for use in directing your health care when you are incapable to do so; the durable power of attorney for health care and the living will. You can use either or both of these documents or you may write out your own wishes and directives. The choice is yours and you can change your mind at any time.

Using the Durable Power of Attorney for health care is the best way to assure that your instructions about health care are followed. Using this document you can designate someone else, called an agent or surrogate, to make decisions about your health care in the event you are unable to do so yourself. This person, can, by law, be anyone you choose over the age of 18, except the doctor providing you care. This person will have the legal right and responsibility to make decisions about your health care, including the initiation and termination of medical procedures and life support systems, organ donation, and autopsy. Most people select a member of their family or a close friend to act as their surrogate. You may designate several surrogates, in case your first choice of a decision maker is unavailable or unwilling to serve. Whoever you choose, you should discuss your wishes with them. While your caregivers must respect your surrogate's decision and the court will uphold them, the surrogate or agent can be removed by the court if doing so is determined to be in your best interest.
