

Children's Eye Health & Safety Month

Children are highly vulnerable to eye-related issues, and early detection is crucial. Eye problems, such as refractive errors, amblyopia (lazy eye) and strabismus (crossed eyes) can be treated effectively if identified early.

Look for the following eye problems in children:

- Squinting
- Frequent Headaches
- Rubbing Eyes Excessively
- Holding Objects Too Close



Children are naturally curious, and their explorations can sometimes lead to eye injuries. Create a safe environment by removing potential hazards such as sharp objects, harmful chemicals, and unsafe toys.
