Osteoporosis

Osteoporosis causes bones to be fragile and easily broken. These fractures can be severe, causing prolonged pain and in some cases, disability. Catching osteoporosis early and seeking medical treatment can prevent fractures or worsening of the condition. One in three women and one in five men over the age of 50 will suffer an osteoporosis related fracture or bone break.

The U.S. Preventive Services Task Force currently recommends screening for osteoporosis in all women 65 years and older and postmenopausal women younger than 65 years at increased risk using a clinical risk assessment tool.

There often are no symptoms in the early stages of bone loss, but once osteoporosis weakens your bones, you might have symptoms of a fracture that include:

- Back pain caused by a broken bone or a collapsed bone in the spine.
- Loss of height over time.
- A stooped posture.
- A bone that breaks much more easily than expected.

Ways to Help Prevent Osteoporosis:

- Getting enough Vitamin D and Calcium.
- Staying active with weightbearing exercises.
- Avoiding smoking.
- Avoiding excess drinking.
