Blood Pressures

- If you are checking blood pressures at home, be sure that before you begin that you have the manual that came with the machine. Even if you think you know all about it, it is still recommended that you refresh your memory.
- If you have more than one machine, be careful not to mix up the cuffs. Use the cuff that came with the machine. Mixing them can cause inaccurate readings.
- Be rested at least 5 minutes before taking the reading.
- Follow directions on proper placement of the cuff.
- If you are routinely checking, try to take it at the same time every day.
- Keep records and take them to your doctors appointments.
- Repeat the measurement if you are unsure of the results.
- If you are really concerned about very abnormal readings, seek medical attention at the walk in clinic, the ER, or call 911 for emergencies.
- If it is just a routine check and not an emergency, do not take within 30 minutes of eating, drinking, smoking, or exercising. You should not be physically tired or exhausted while taking a measurement.
- Do not regulate medications based on your findings. This is done by your doctor. Also, follow the diet that has been calculated for you.
