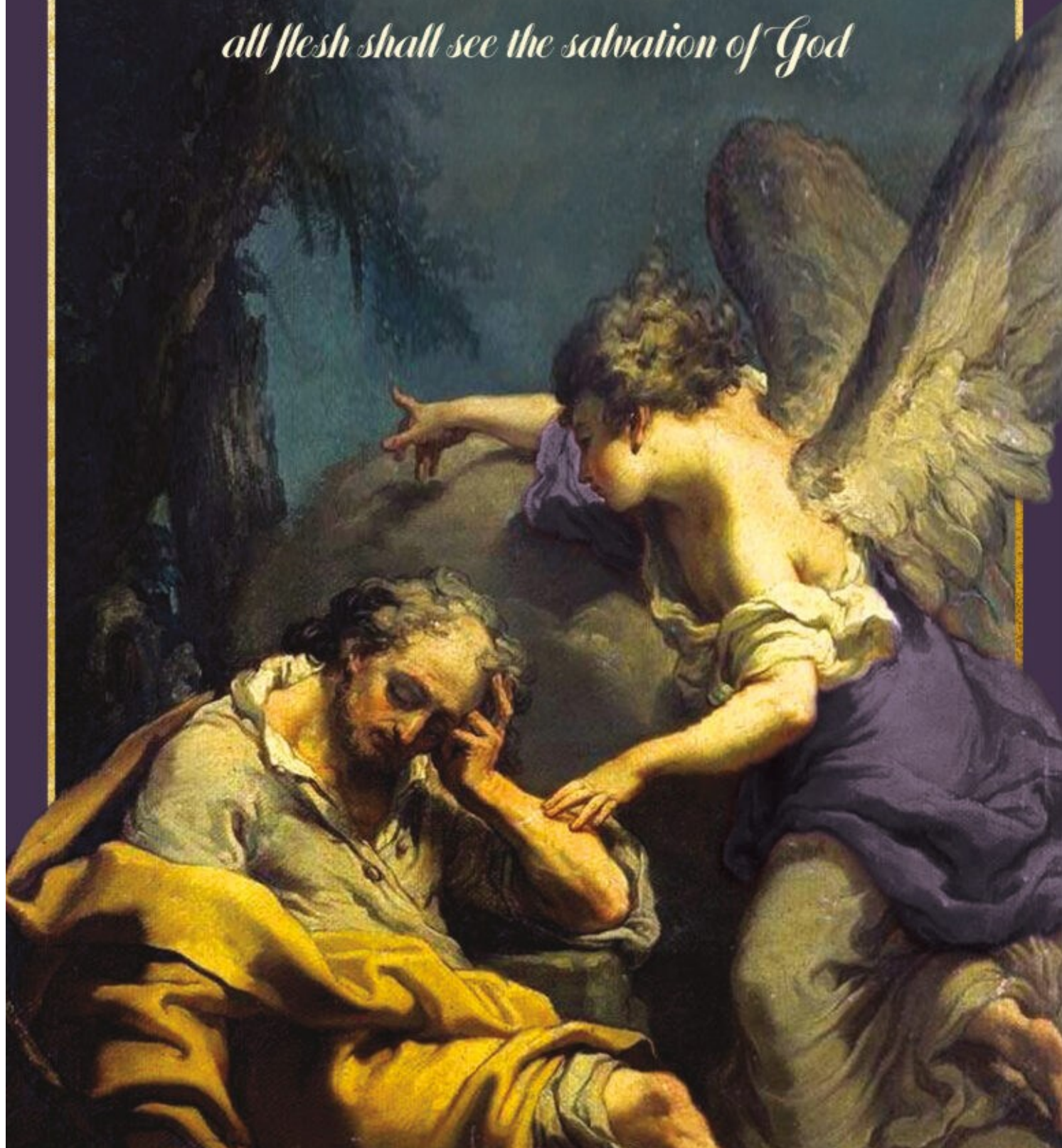

Healthy Pets..... Healthy People

Pets can enrich our lives, filling them with love and other health benefits like lowered blood pressure, triglycerides, and cholesterol levels. Pets often provide companionship that is beneficial to levels of depression by decreasing our loneliness. They often cause us to get out of the house and get moving, helping us exercise regularly in order to walk and let them use the "toilet", and get much needed fresh air and sunshine.

While pets offer myriad benefits, they also add some risk to our lives, including that of diseases that can be passed between animals and humans. These diseases are termed zoonotic diseases (including Lyme disease, Salmonella and others).

Zoonotic diseases are very common, both in the United States and around the world. Scientists estimate that more than 6 out of every 10 known infectious diseases in people can spread from animals, and 3 out of every 4 new or emerging infectious diseases in people come from animals. To decrease the chance of acquiring a zoonotic disease, please wash your hands regularly and review all of the following information provided in the following link:
