One of the UK's youngest commissioned composers and youngest-ever national radio presenter

Composer and songwriter

- In his teens, composed classical orchestral works for the **Royal Opera House**, **Classic FM**'s 25th birthday, the 125th birthday of the **Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra** and the **Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra**
- Written songs performed by **The Band of HM Royal Marines**, soprano **Camilla Kerslake** and Canadian jazz group **SymphRONica** (including a **JUNO Award**-nominated album)
- **In 2025, he premiered his song** *Harmony* **for HM King Charles III at St James's Palace**. It marked the first time His Majesty's environmental philosophy of Harmony was expressed in music.
- New dance-theatre show, *Duet*, tells the true story of his piano teacher; developed in association with The Lowry, Southampton Mayflower and Norwich Theatres. - **Children's seaside show,** *Gulls and Buoys* (book, music and lyrics by Jack) tours schools in areas lacking significant arts education provision every summer. A mentor trained by Jack teaches a Year 6 class the show over six weeks, and Jack accompanies the final performance.
- **New stage musical,** *Unleashed***, written with Matt Edmondson**, received its first public showcases at MAST Studios in 2024.

Broadcaster

- Aged 19, Jack helped build and launch a new national classical music radio station for **Bauer Media**: **Scala Radio**. Now **Magic Radio's Magic Classical**, he presents on Saturday and Sunday afternoons, with past guests including **Gary Barlow**, **Lang Lang**, **Itzhak Perlman**, **Jools Holland**, **Katherine Jenkins**, **Cameron Mackintosh** and **Simon Rattle**.
- Hosts the Musical Theatre and Classical shows for British Airways and Aer Lingus worldwide
- Hosted specials for Magic Radio's Magic at the Musicals and Jazz FM.
- Co-hosted the live **Medici TV** coverage of the 2025 **Verbier Festival**
- Aged 19, he was named as one of ReelWorld Radio Academy's 30 Under 30

Writer

- A regular writer for **Gramophone** and **Musicals** Magazine
- Has contributed to **The Times**, **The Telegraph** and **The Daily Mirror**
- His debut book, 'Raising The Roof', was released in 2024 via Templar / Bonnier Books

The campaign culminated in two Proms at the Royal Albert Hall, with 3000 young musicians from across the UK performing 25 minutes of Jack's music. It returned in 2024 supported by the BBC, with Jack appearing on The One Show and BBC Radios 2, 3 and 4.
