

Jack Pepper (b.1999)

Jack is a composer, broadcaster and writer.

Jack has composed for the Royal Opera House, Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra, Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra, Royal Philharmonic Society, The Band of HM Royal Marines and Classic FM. He has recorded his work with acclaimed international conductors including Sir Antonio Pappano, Vasily Petrenko and Kirill Karabits, and his music has appeared on the BBC and Classic FM.

Alongside classical composition, Jack also enjoys writing popular songs and jazz. His piece for the Canadian ensemble SymphRONica was performed at the Canada 150 celebrations in Trafalgar Square, whilst his song for the Holocaust Educational Trust (HET), 'One Day' was performed live at the HET Appeal Dinner in 2017, before an esteemed audience including cabinet members and celebrities. He is a Trustee of the DMRC Benevolent Fund at Headley Court / Stanford Hall, and his original song for the charity – 'A Special Place' – was premiered at Headley Court's final ever Beating Retreat Ceremony in July 2018, and subsequently performed at the charity's October 2018 Gala Dinner in front of royalty and other esteemed guests.

Jack is a presenter for Bauer Media's brand-new entertainment-led classical music radio station, Scala Radio, which broadcasts live from March 2019. Jack joins a presenter line-up that includes Simon Mayo, Mark Kermode and Goldie. Jack has also presented for Resonance FM, and has written for BBC Music Magazine, Gramophone and Opera.
