Primary Programs

Pawsitively Healing Summer Camps for children ages 8–13, focused on building social and emotional resiliency in at-risk youth by cultivating empathy, stress management, self-esteem, and communication/relationships.

Paws on the Ground program, offering emergency rescue, intervention, and support for canines and their caretakers.

Spay/Neuter Taskforce providing both large clinics and regular private appointments for spaying and neutering dogs and cats.

Suicide Prevention

Montana has the second-highest suicide rate in the country and Montana's Native suicide rate is more than five times the statewide rate. Trauma is one of the leading causes of suicide, and dogs are powerful healers. By placing dogs with at-risk youth and teaching them to interact in a healthy way, we aim to build resilience and help children cope with their trauma.
