Our recital takes place in a public school facility. Alcohol, tobacco products, vaping, cannabis, illegal substances, firearms, weapons, or any other prohibited items are not allowed anywhere on school grounds. Failure to follow school district policies may result in removal from the event and/or dismissal from South Sound Dance programs.

Help Us Keep Dancers Safe

Dancers should remain in designated backstage areas unless directed by SSD staff. Parents and family members should follow all check-in, drop-off, and pick-up procedures and respect all backstage access restrictions.

Be a Great Audience

Cheer loudly, encourage all dancers, silence cell phones, and help us create a welcoming environment where every performer feels celebrated!

Please do not enter or exit the auditorium during performances, and no flash photography is permitted.
