

Learning choreography and performing on stage is a essential part of the dance class experience! As a member with SSD your dancer will be learning choreography to perform in both the Holiday Show and Annual Recital. This practice and experience gives dancers both technical and social emotional skills that will grow their confidence and belief in their self!

HOLIDAY SHOW & RECITAL PRODUCTION INVESTMENT:

Covers: theater rental & staffing, choreography, rehearsals, costume, and themed show gift.

- Ages 2-9: \$119 + tax / \$99 + tax per additional class
- Ages 10+ (incl. adults): \$129 + tax / \$109 + tax per additional class

Production fees are per class. Multiple classes = multiple fees. Classes may perform in different shows. To help with costs, we use "Build Your Own" (BYO) costumes whenever possible.

TICKETS

\$26-\$36 each. Kids 2 & under free. Performers do not need tickets.

#1 EXPERIENCE

At South Sound Dance we work to make every performance the BEST EXPERIENCE for all of our families and dancers, ensuring that every dancer has their moment on stage! In fact, out of our 400 performers last season ALL made it out on stage!

#2 CONFIDENCE

Performing BUILDS CONFIDENCE and EMPOWERMENT in our kids. It's a moment to experience vulnerability, to put their whole self out there, and to believe in theirselves. It's something that they achieve, that they get to say "I DID IT!"

#3 There is an "I" in TEAM

Recital teaches both the meaning of the word TEAM and INDIVIDUAL. Dancers learn to work to gether and to own their individual strengths to achieve a group performance.

#4 PRACTICE: GAME as PRACTICE: PERFORM

Recital is the "game" if you will, to soccer practice. Would you sign up your child for a sport if there was never a game? No, right? Because in a sport we are learning how to play a game. In dance, we are learning how to PERFORM!
