# **Tuition & Policies**

- Payment for class is due prior to the start of class. All students must see the front desk prior to the start class.
- ALL STUDENTS MUST SIGN A WAIVER BEFORE TAKING ANY CLASS WITH SOUTH SOUND DANCE.
- New registration students may pay the drop-in rate for a trial class. If the student chooses to enroll in the class after the trial, the tuition will be pro-rated for that month.
- Youth registration students owe an annual registration fee of \$15.00, \$5.00 per each additional child per family.
- We require that every tuition student keep a credit card on file. Automatic payments are optional.
- Tuition is due by the 6<sup>th</sup> day of every month and is non-refundable. On the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the month, late accounts will be charged a \$10.00 late fee and the credit card on file will be automatically charged for the balance due, plus the \$10.00 late fee.
- Non-sufficient checks are subject to a \$25.00 fine.
- Monthly tuition will remain the same whether it's a short (3-week) or long (5-week) month. Tuition is due September –
  June.
- If a student is withdrawing from a class the studio must be informed with written notice at least two weeks or 14 days prior to the end of the month, otherwise the account will be charged for full tuition the following month. Students withdrawing registration prior to the start of the fall semester will receive a refund of tuition only if done before the start of the first class.
- There are NO REFUNDS for missed classes. Makeup classes are only available for excused absences with instructor and studio approval. Makeup classes are not granted for every missed class and will only be allowed if there is an available class that meets the needs and requirements for the student.
- Students are strongly encouraged to attend every class. Excused absences include illness, birth or death in the family, family wedding, etc. with permission of the studio. If you know your child will not be in class, please call the studio. Only excused absences will be given the consideration of a makeup class.
- Students who miss more than four classes in the Fall Semester will not be allowed to participate in the Winter Showcase. Students who miss more than six classes in the Spring Semester will not be allowed to participate in the Spring Recital. Any student who is absent the last week of class before the Winter Showcase or Spring Recital will not be allowed to participate unless it is an excused absence that has been pre-approved by the instructor and studio.
- Minors under the age of 10 must have a parent enter the building and remain with them until the student has entered the classroom. After they have entered the classroom parents are free to leave and are encouraged to do so.
- Minors must be picked up at class end time.
   If any minor is remaining in the building
   10 minutes after his or her class without
   a parent, there will be an additional charge of
   \$1.00 per minute. If 30 minutes elapse and the
   minor is still unaccompanied by a parent
   CPS will be called.

# Studio Etiquette

- Parents are advised to assist student with drop off, check-in, and payment and then leave the studio until it is time to pick up their student. Students get very distracted by continuous parent observation and our lobby is simply too small to hold everyone during class time. If parent chooses to stay, please wait quietly in the lobby. Parents are only allowed to sit in the classroom area during Parent Watch Week.
- Students should arrive ten minutes prior to class start time to sign in, make payment, and begin the class on time.
- Students should arrive in appropriate dance attire for class. Youth registration classes have a
  required dress code. Find your specific class attire at <a href="www.shopnimbly.com/southsounddance">www.shopnimbly.com/southsounddance</a>.
  Adults and Mini Camps dancers please wear leotards, tights, leggings, and yoga or exercise wear.
  Please try to arrive dressed and ready for class, as we do not have a bathroom accessible in the lobby.
- Please try to use restrooms between classes or at class end, as they are located at the back of each dance studio.
- Students should have appropriate dance shoes, example ballet or jazz shoes. If a student is dropping in or trying the class for the first time, socks or bare feet are allowed. Review your class dress code list.
- Students are expected to have hair pulled back and secured out of the face. Hair kits are available for purchase at the front desk.
- Students should wait QUIETLY in the hallway for class to begin and remain in the hallway until the instructor takes students on to the dance floor. The lobby and hallway are a WHISPER ZONE! Noise can be heard in Studio A, so to be respectful to the students and instructors that are in class please keep voices silent or to a whisper.
- Students should take all belongings and items into the classroom. DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS IN THE LOBBY OR HALLWAY.
- Students are expected to treat other students, instructors, and all South Sound Dance Staff with respect and kindness.
- Students are expected to clean up after themselves and treat the facility with respect. No running through the facility, climbing on furniture, or kicking the walls, etc.
- No gum, food, or beverages allowed other than water in the classroom.

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

# Holiday Show

\$60.00 + tax - for students in classes age 7 - 9

70.00 + tax - for students in classes age 10 & up

\*Costume fees are per class. Therefore, if your child is enrolled in more than one class there will be additional costume fees per each class your child or children take (except for classes designated tech only).
