ADDITIONAL COSTUMES

Costume fees are per class. Therefore, if your child is enrolled in more than one class there will be additional costume fees per each class your child or children take. We also try to create Build Your Own costumes to help alleviate costume expenses for students enrolled in multiple classes. \$59 Holiday Show per additional costume; \$79 Annual Recital additional costume. Tax not included.

#1 EXPERIENCE

In fact, out of our 350 performers last season we only had 2 tiny dancers that did not go out on stage for dress rehearsal, but they made it out for recital!

#2 CONFIDENCE

Recital and performing in general BUILDS CONFIDENCE and EMPOWERMENT in our kids. It's something that they achieve, that they get to say "I DID IT!"

#3 There is an "I" in TEAM

Recital teaches both the meaning of the word TEAM and INDIVIDUAL. Dancers learn to work together and to own their individual strengths to achieve a group performance.

#4 PRACTICE: GAME as PRACTICE: PERFORM
