The Broward Victim's Rights Coalition Rebecca Lee Knox Crime Victim Assistance Fund recognizes that crime victims and survivors may suffer financial hardship as a result of their victimization. Hardships may include, but are not limited to: housing, utilities, food, furnishings, clothing, childcare, rent deposits, transportation, medical care, and other basic needs.

The purpose of the Fund is to provide limited immediate financial assistance to crime victims and/or their immediate families when no other funds are available.

In 2024 the Rebecca Lee Knox Fund was utilized 13 times. The fund was used to assist 3 victims of domestic violence, 1 victim of DUI, 4 homicide survivors, 2 attempted murder victims, 2 sexual battery victims and their families, and 1 stalking victim.
