

## 2024 YEAR-END HIGH POINT PROGRAM

- 1. Owner or lessee AND exhibitor of horse/pony/mini must be a member of Wisconsin PtHA in 2024 *prior to showing in any eligible class.*
- 2. Exhibitor/equine combination must attend both 2024 WPtHA Horse Shows to qualify for any Year-End and All-Around Awards..
- 3. Two awards (Grand and Reserve) will be given in each individual Year-End Award Division.
- 4. All horses/ponies/minis or AM/YA combinations must earn points in both <u>Halter</u> and <u>Performance</u> type classes in order to qualify for any All-Around Award.
- 5. All ties will be broken by the Horse/Pony/Mini or AM/YA combination with the most firsts, then seconds, then thirds etc., then most classes shown.
- 6. Leadline Class is a non-ROM class and does not count towards any Year-End Youth award or All-Around Youth award.
- 7. Any violation of National Pinto rules and/or Wisconsin Pinto rules shall result in disqualification for any High Point Awards.
