Come to **terms** **quickly** with your **accuser** while you are going with him to **court**, **lest** your accuser hand you over to the **judge**, and the judge to the **guard**, and you be put in **prison**. **Truly**, I say to you, you will never get out until you have **paid** the **last penny**.”

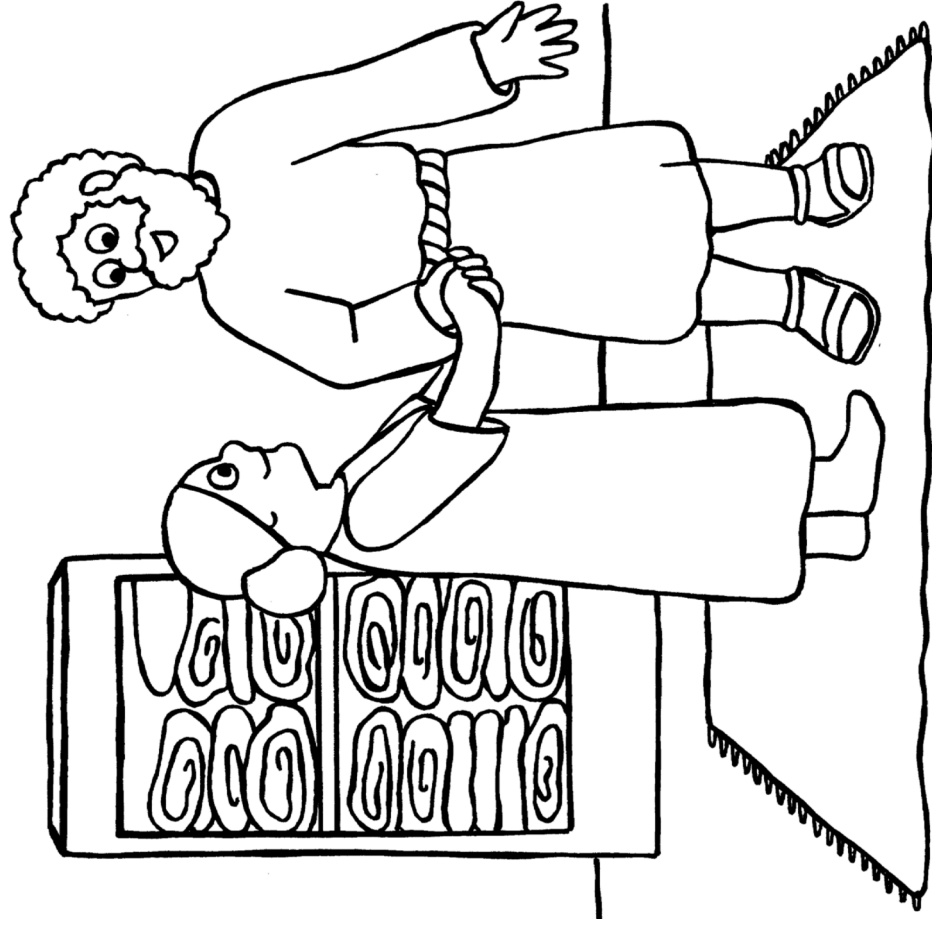




We all sin and do what we want instead of obeying God. To teach us how to live, God gave us some rules called, "Commandments."
