

These things I have **spoken** to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full. "This is my commandment, that you **love one another** as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that someone **lay down his life** for his **friends**. You are my friends if you do what I command you. No longer do I **call** you **servants**, for the servant does not know what his **master** is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have **heard** from my Father I have made **known** to you. You did not **choose** me, but I **choose** you and **appointed** you that you should go and **bear fruit** and that your fruit should abide, so that **whatever** you ask the Father in my **name**, he may **give** it to you. These things I command you, so that you will love one another.



