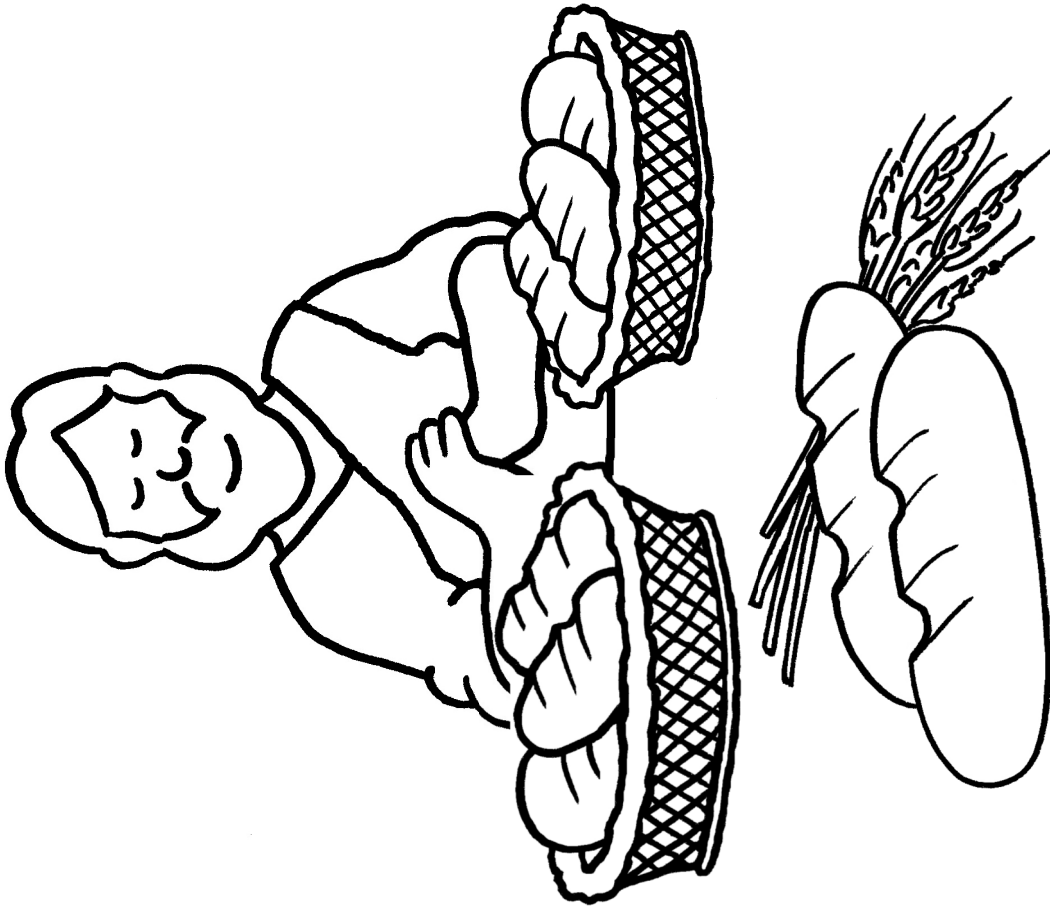

Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me **shall not hunger**, and whoever believes in me **shall never thirst**."

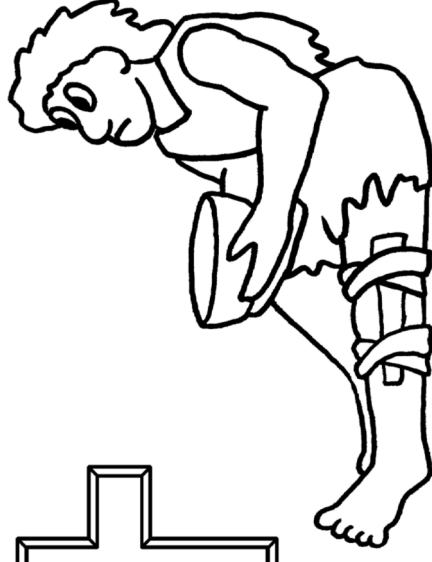
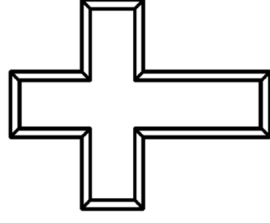
How do you think God feels when we aren't thankful for what he's given us? Why? Write about it here:
