Lester Chang was elected to the New York State Assembly on November 8, 2022. The 49th Assembly District represents parts of Kings County.

Lester, born in America to Chinese immigrant parents who came in pursuit of the American Dream, grew up on Eldridge Street in the Lower East Side of Manhattan. He is the proud product of New York's public education system and has attended public school through his master's degree. After graduating high school, he began studying at Brooklyn College to pursue a career in banking and finance. Eventually, he earned his master's degree in International Transportation from SUNY Maritime College and started a career in logistics.

Lester served in the Navy Reserve and New York Naval Militia, including a tour in Afghanistan. He has 20 years management experience in global trade and logistics. In March 2020, Lester volunteered to return to active duty during the pandemic in support of COVID mitigation efforts and helped convert the Jacob Javits Convention Center into a field hospital that treated more than 1,000 COVID patients.

Additionally, he has worked with the Board of Elections as a Poll Site Coordinator for more than 30 years.
