***Navy Combat Search and Rescue  
During the Vietnam War***

**Marc Liebman, Citizen Sailor, Businessman and Author**

Marc retired as a Captain after twenty-four years in the Navy and is a combat veteran of Vietnam, the Tanker Wars of the 1980s and Desert Shield/Storm. He is a Naval Aviator with just under 6,000 hours of flight time in helicopters and fixed wing aircraft. Captain Liebman has worked with the armed forces of Australia, Canada, Japan, Thailand, Republic of Korea, the Philippines and the U.K.

He has been a partner in two different consulting firms advising clients on business and operational strategy, business process re-engineering, sales and marketing; the CEO of an aerospace and defense manufacturing company; an associate editor of a national magazine and a copywriter for an advertising agency.

The Liebmans live near Aubrey, Texas. Marc is married to Betty, his lovely wife of 48+ years. They spend a lot of time in their RV and visiting their four grandchildren.

Marc's latest career is as a novelist and six of his books – *Cherubs 2*, *Big Mother 40*, *Render Harmless*, *Forgotten*, *Inner Look* and *Moscow Airlift* have been published. A seventh - *The Simushir Island Incident* - will be released in early 2019.

*Big Mother 40* was ranked by the readers who buy books on Amazon as one of the top 100 war novels. *Forgotten* was a 2017 Finalist in Historical Fiction in the Next Generation Indie Book Awards; a Finalist in Fiction in the 2017 Literary Excellence Awards; and rated as Five Star by Readers Favorites. *Inner Look* was also rated Five Star by Readers Favorites.



- **Cherubs 2** – Josh Haman is a newly minted Naval Aviator/helicopter pilot and is assigned to his first detachment to fly combat search and rescue missions. Not only does he have to transition to a new helicopter, but he finds out his detachment officer-in-charge and helicopter aircraft commander is a coward. Later on, he finds himself learning how to fly special operations missions to of all places, the People's Republic of China. **(\$19.95)**
- **Big Mother 40** – A secret missile base in North Vietnam is shooting down Air Force fighter bombers at an alarming rate. Josh Haman and Marty Cabot are, along with other missions, tasked to find and then raid the base code named Venom by the North Vietnamese. On Venom, a Soviet surface-to-air missile expert is testing his theories and his government is more interested in testing tactics than how many are shot down. The North Vietnamese leaders are pushing the North Vietnamese Army base commander to have the Soviets shoot down more airplanes. **(\$19.95)**
- **Render Harmless** – Thirty-one years after WWII ended, Nazis want to create a Fourth Reich and will stop at nothing. They are aligned with Red Hand - a shadowy terrorist organization supported by the East German Stasi and Fatah. Red Hand's manifesto reads as if it was written by Adolph Hitler and the group is creating the West German government's worst political nightmare – Germans are once again killing Jews. Haman and Cabot are part of a Joint U.S./U.K. Team created to find the members of Red Hand and *render them harmless* to the United States and her allies. **(\$19.95)**
- **Forgotten** – Six Americans are held by a drug lord along the Laotian/North Vietnamese border and not released in 1974. The Americans are rescued nine years after the war ended and when they return, two Americas, one a CIA officer and another a former POW want the returned POWs dead. Both men are afraid their return will lead to charges of treason. And, one of the wives, an anti-war activist gets sent to Cuba by the Students of a Democratic Society to learn to be an assassin. **(\$22.50)**
- **Inner Look** – In the wake of the arrest of John Walker and Jerry Whitworth, the Navy wants to find out if there are any more traitors in the Navy. The trail leads Josh Haman and Marty Cabot first to the head of the Senate Intelligence Committee and ultimately to a woman in the CIA who wants revenge on the U.S. The trail leads them to Argentina where they find out that not only is the U.S. Looking for her, but the KGB wants to bring her to either Havana or Moscow. **(\$22.50)**
- **Moscow Airlift** – The Soviet Union is descending into chaos. It is broke, its people are facing starvation, the Warsaw Pact has collapsed and hardliners want to end Gorbachev's policies of perestroika and glasnost. A Soviet General, seeing and uncertain economic future, decides to sell tactical nuclear weapons to Iran so they can attack Israel. Josh Haman is sent to Moscow to be the eyes and ears of the Marine General who is the Joint Chiefs of Staff J-3 (Operations). While there, he meets a former girlfriend who disappeared in a Laotian re-education camp in 1970 and hadn't seen since and mission scope creep occurs when he is asked to stop the transfer of the nuclear weapons. **(\$22.50)**
