Our mission is to empower people to experience healing in their lives, to restore healthy relationships with themselves, significant others, and with society.

The House of Hope an 8 bed residential rehab facility set on two acres on the outskirts of Geelong.

The program is six months live in and offers a holistic approach to substance recovery.

Commonly asked questions

What are the costs involved? 80% of your full Centrelink benefit before any deductions e.g.: housing, debts, centre- pay.

What if I don't receive Centrelink? Our staff will have a discussion one on one around the costs.

Do I have to pay up front? On intake you will be asked to pay two weeks upfront.

Can I have mobile devices or laptops? Participants are not permitted to bring in laptops, tablets or smart watches. Mobile phones will be stored in a locked safe and used to access MyGov or for other necessary needs related to your rehab stay.

Can I have visitors? From the second weekend, participants can nominate immediate family to visit on the weekend; this must be booked in no later than the Thursday before in one of the available time slots.

Can I have phone calls to family? Participants can have one 10min incoming or outgoing phone call Mon – Frid between 5pm and 9pm and two 10min or one 20min call Saturday and Sundays.

Can I have family drop things into during the week? When you first arrive, you can have one drop off by arrangement with staff of anything you may have forgotten.

Commonly asked questions Ctd.

Am I expected to participate in all aspects of the program? Participating in all aspects of the program is required during your stay. We do work with individuals with physical and other limitations to adjust some aspects of the program accordingly.

As a faith-based organization we attend Church on a Sunday.

Do I get leave? Weekend leave may be requested after completing 10 weeks. First Weekend leave is Saturday day leave only from 9am-5pm. After this you may be granted an overnight leave, exit time on full weekend leave is 9am returning no later than 5pm Sunday.

How much luggage can I bring? There is a limit of 2 bags or suitcases of luggage on Intake. We can provide you with a packing list.

Do I have my own room? Yes you will have your own room with king single bed, desk and chair and wardrobe. All bed linen and towels are provided for your stay.
