Miss Camille began her ballet and gymnastics journey when she was very young. She performed ballet worldwide at a number of academies, including those in Paris and Tokyo. And she competed in gymnastics in many countries across continental Europe.

Miss Camille was selected for the National Team at age 11, and she was a European Gold Medalist and a National Champion in Rhythmic Gymnastics at age 15.

Miss Camille's passion for teaching ballet and gymnastics developed after her successful career, and she has mentored individuals and teams in Europe and in the United States. She has mentored athletes and performers at all levels- from novice to medalist- in private individual, group, and academy settings.

Camille was named a Burgundy Council Scholar and was awarded a full Academic Scholarship by the French Ministry of Culture and Communication to Nagoya University (Japan), where she was awarded the Master of Architecture degree with Honors. She studied architecture and fine arts at the Pantheon-Sorbonne University de Paris, the Ecole Nationale Supérieur des Beaux-Arts de Paris, and the Ecole Nationale des Beaux-Arts de Dijon, where she was awarded the Bachelor of Arts and Urbanism with High Honors. Her work was recognized with the High Laureate Award by the École Nationale Jury of the French National Ministry of Education.
