

Annual Congregational Meeting 2023

Sunday, January 29, 2023

The annual Congregational Meeting will be held January 29, 2023, immediately following the worship service. The meeting will be live-streamed (Link) for members who are not able to attend in person. At present, the agenda includes the following items:

- 1. Proposed amendments to the constitution, mandated by ELCA synodical action last year.
- 2. Election of Council: Two council positions for 3-year terms need to be filled, and congregational approval of Becky Wehman to continue for the two remaining years (she was selected by the council in early 2022 to fill a vacancy).
- 3. Approval of the 2023 Budget.

Copies of the proposed agenda items will be made available in early January. Annual reports about Zion's activities in 2022 will also be shared. Additional agenda items should be proposed to the Council before its January 8, 2023, meeting. **Super Special Note:** If there is interest, it has been proposed that the meeting be followed by a potluck lunch. All in favor say, "Yum!"

Zion's Building Maintenance Fund is a designated budgetary fund through which Zion family members can donate specifically for the maintenance and improvement of our church building and parsonage - think electric, plumbing, painting, roof repair, etc. To date, donations to the fund have provided a large portion of the cost of the new A/C unit, as well as the cost of much-needed plumbing repairs.
