

Prayer Ministry - Volunteer Opportunity

Now that the holidays are over and we're in a new year, are you wondering where you might volunteer your time (or more of your time) to make an impact in our local community?

I would like to invite you to consider assisting me with the ministry at the Lake County Jail (a/k/a Detention Center) in Tavares, specifically with the Christian book carts. We have 2 book carts, but I can only push one. With a second person, we can offer a larger and more timely selection of Christian books to the female inmates.

Your time commitment would be Wednesday from 12:30 to around 3:00pm. Unfortunately, I am unable to provide transportation as I spend the whole day. The jail is a unique environment that most of us haven't had any contact with in any capacity, so you may have lots of questions. I've been doing this for many years now, so I'm confident that I can answer any questions you may have.

The Lake County Jail only allows volunteers to work with inmates of the same sex, so I'm looking for a woman (or women) to help with the women's book carts. If any men are interested, I can answer any questions you may have and put you in touch with the Chaplain to discuss taking the men's Christian book cart to the male inmates. At present, we do not have anyone doing that. Thank you for considering this ministry opportunity.

Two Separate Congregational Meetings Sunday, Feb. 12, 2023

Congregational Meeting to Consider Pastoral Call (Meeting #1)

Our Zion Lutheran Church Council is excited to announce that there will be a special Congregational Meeting to consider extending a call to Pastor Karin Albaugh. This will take place on February 12 (Sunday) at about 12 noon (immediately following the worship service). A written ballot will be provided with a single motion for congregational voting. Active members of Zion present in-person will be eligible to vote.

Please note: The previously-announced regular Annual Congregational Meeting, also to be held on February 12th, will immediately follow this meeting. Further info will be coming on both meetings.

Annual Congregational Meeting 2023 (Meeting #2)

The Annual Congregational Meeting will be held February 12, 2023, immediately following the meeting to consider a pastoral call. The Annual Congregational Meeting will be live-streamed (Link) for members who are not able to attend in person. At present, the agenda includes the following items:

- Proposed amendments to the constitution, mandated by ELCA synodical action last year. Full details
 of the proposed amendments are attached to the email with which you received this ZC
 newsletter.
- 2. Election of Council: Two council positions for 3-year terms need to be filled, and congregational approval of Becky Wehman to continue for the two remaining years (she was selected by the council in early 2022 to fill a vacancy).
- 3. Approval of the 2023 Budget.

Copies of the proposed agenda items will be made available in late January. Annual reports about Zion's activities in 2022 will also be shared. Additional agenda items should be proposed to the Council no later than January 22, 2023.
