

One Person Really Can Make a Difference!

While most of us at Zion know of and greatly appreciate the efforts of our efficient, hard-working treasurer, John Renn, in keeping our church finances in order, many may not know that John's commitment to stewardship and service to others extends beyond dollars and cents to a medical equipment ministry. Operating out of Zion's outdoor shed, John collects and stores a supply of various types of medical equipment which he freely offers to anyone at all - Zion family members, friends, neighbors or complete strangers.

Most of the equipment comes from individuals who purchased the equipment for their personal use but no longer need it. The collection includes wheelchairs, walkers, potty chairs and more. Borrowed equipment can be kept and used for as long as needed with no requirement that it ever be returned. Also included in the collection are approximately 10-12 grab bars that John is happy to give to anyone who may need them. Even better, he has volunteered to install them free of charge.
