

Day of Pentecost

Sunday, May 28th - Wear Red to Church!

Pentecost marks the fiftieth day of the Easter season, and the fulfillment of Easter is celebrated at Pentecost. Pentecost Sunday is often referred to as the birthday of the church because Pentecost is when the apostles received the gift of the Holy Spirit and first went out among the people spreading Jesus' message, thus establishing the beginning of the church. The liturgical color of Pentecost is red, and the symbols of Pentecost are wind, fire and a dove (Acts 2).

Strengthening Our Prayer Ministry

Zion's worship team, of which the prayer ministry is a meaningful component, has recently been exploring ways to strengthen this vital ministry, both for those in need of prayer and for those who faithfully respond to the requests for prayer. We've come up with a few changes that we believe will greatly enhance our prayer ministry.

Sunday Spoken Prayer Requests - Each Sunday at the start of worship, Pastor Karin offers us all the opportunity to share our spoken prayer requests. These requests are lifted up during that week's service.

Sunday Printed Prayer List*- You may request that your name, or that of others, be added to our printed prayer list. This is a public list that will be distributed each week in the red worship folders. We ask that you regularly follow up with updates. We try not to remove any name until we hear that the need has passed, but we also want to be sure our list reflects the current concerns accurately.

Prayer Request Email Tree* - More immediate prayer requests can be shared with our Zion family via our email tree. These email prayer requests can include as little or as much information as you like. If you are seeking prayer for someone other than yourself, please ask that person's permission first.

Synod Assembly 2023 - Renewed in Christ

Friday, June 8th thru Sunday, June 10th in Orlando

Each year, Synod leaders, clergy, congregational leaders, and laity of the Florida-Bahamas Synod gather for a joy-filled time of worship, workshops, decision-making and fellowship. The theme of the **2023 Synod Assembly** is "Renewed in Christ" based on Hebrews 13:6-8. This year's keynote speaker is **Bishop Patricia Ann Curtis Davenport**.

In alternating years, the 3-day agenda at Assembly either focuses more on workshop sessions and provides dozens of workshops covering all areas of congregational ministry, or the agenda focuses more on plenary (business of the church) sessions. 2023 is the year of mostly plenary sessions, and important business will be conducted by those attending as designated voting delegate(s) from each congregation.

Assembly 2023 will be held in Orlando from June 8-10, 2023. For us at Zion, commuting for 1 or more days is an easy option for those who prefer not to stay overnight. For more info, please talk with Pastor, one of our Zion Council members, or email the **church office**.
