

Day of Pentecost

Sunday, June 5, 2022 - Wear Red to Church!

Pentecost Sunday marks the fiftieth day of the Easter season, and the fulfillment of Easter is celebrated at Pentecost. The promised counselor comes to the faithful, and the church rejoices that God's mission in Jesus is for all the world's people. Pentecost Sunday is often referred to as the birthday of the church because Pentecost is when the apostles first went out among the people spreading Jesus' message, thus establishing the beginning of the church. The liturgical color of Pentecost is red. The symbols of Pentecost are wind, fire and a dove (Acts 2). Many Christians wear red on Pentecost to symbolize the tongues of fire that appeared over the heads of the apostles.

Pastor Hoven then asked if I could provide the pattern so his mother-in-law could crochet them, and I emailed the pattern to him. When I asked him earlier this week if his mother-in-law has been able to keep up with the demand, he replied: "She has, thanks! She used to make baby blankets for the hospital, but they don't need them anymore, so she has switched gears. We had a synod council retreat this weekend, and for devotion time I took prayer squares and gave one to each member of the synod council to carry with us as we do our work. There was delight in the sharing. All of this said, I'll always find homes for them, and if you have extras I'm happy to take them."

Then my brother, George, phoned me from Pennsylvania and asked if I could send him another box of prayer squares as he had given away all that I had sent previously. Of course, I honored his request, too.

Lastly, Joan Missell asked me if I had talked about the prayer squares with Davis, the missionary from Africa, who worshiped with us during his knee surgery and recovery. At that time, I hadn't; but, I made a point of talking with him about them. He said he would take some home with him, but was limited because of luggage restrictions. He said he may have a friend who lives in our area get more from us and ship them to him in the future.
