

Bible Study - (cont.)

Fortunately for me, and for all of us at Zion, we now have three spiritfilled opportunities to gather for Bible study with one another:

- Pastor's weekly Bible study meets via Zoom every Thursday at 2:00pm. Pastor leads the class in studying the 2nd Lesson for the upcoming Sunday worship service. The scripture is read aloud, and Pastor then leads the group in a thought-provoking discussion of the message. All are invited to join. With the Zoom format, attendees can participate from near and far. Every Thursday morning, Pastor sends an email with that week's Zoom meeting link. Please contact Pastor Nielsen to be added to his email list.
- Every Monday morning at 8:30am, the **men of Zion** meet for breakfast, coffee, fellowship and an informal (no homework!) Bible study. The study is based on the weekly lessons printed in the *Celebrate* worship insert which we use during Sunday services. The men read through the scripture lessons and share their thoughts and questions with one another.
- Zion's hybrid-style ((Link)) women's monthly Bible study is held on the 1st Monday of each month (2nd Monday, if the 1st Monday is a holiday). The 35-minute study begins promptly at 10:00am (fellowship at 9:30am). National WELCA-prepared study materials are used in the 35-minute session. Leadership of the study is shared among several women with each bringing her own style and focus.
