

# **Jail Ministry Update**

A few months ago, Chaplain Jim Cornell at the Lake County Detention Center (a/k/a Lake County Jail) was given permission to slowly bring the volunteers back into the facility. In June, he brought in a few volunteers to lead the worship services and gradually added some Bible studies. Thankfully, that went well without any COVID spread, so late in July I was finally given permission to take the Christian book cart to the female inmates. I have a little closer contact with inmates at the book cart, so that's why I was delayed. The women were so excited to see the book cart return, and many expressed their thanks. Hopefully as time goes on, all of the 50+ volunteers will be back to ministering to the spiritual needs of the inmates at the level provided before the Covid-19 pandemic.

Please keep this ministry in mind if you have any Christian books you're willing to part with. The gently-used Christian books can be fiction, non-fiction, biographies, poetry, etc., but must encourage Christian values, be uplifting and encouraging, or be about people who have overcome obstacles. Just remember that the books must be paperback to be allowed into the jail. You can give them to me directly or leave them in the Fellowship Hall with a note with my name on it. Thank you for supporting this ministry.

The Children in Transition program at Groveland Elementary is designed to help homeless children succeed in school. ### How WE Can Help -

Zion has a long history of supporting the Groveland Elementary School CIT program. Throughout the year, we collect supplies that are needed on a daily basis by the children and their families. Donations of the following items are needed: paper towels, toilet tissue, Kleenex tissue, dish soap, bar soap, body wash, wash cloths, hairbrushes, combs, toothpaste, toothbrushes, detergent, shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, and all types of cleaning products.
